As a result of your input and cooperation we will travel Crowfoot Circle first, Siksika Drive then Buffalo and end up at the Tee Garden. Also we will use only 2 Siren sounds to ensure that they are very distinct from one another. Again please report if you hear the sirens or not to the Security 734-3866 or when you leave the Resort. Thanks again.

#1@ 12 noon will signal an emergency situation or it is a serious life hazard where we need help – go immediately to the Tee Garden for further instruction

#2 @12:15 will signal an **immediate evacuation** – load up what you can, head out of the Resort & please heed directions from the Traffic Control Captains. This is the end of testing until further notice.
